Article Kindred Spirit



The Xena community lost a true fan and honorable soul last year. He was a simple man who loved his dog, his Xena collection and his little piece of land near Walker Lake in Nevada. He lived in Hawaii most of his life where he had family and was trying to maintain 3 jobs, the hardest one at night driving a cab. His life was no life trying to keep up with the high cost of living in Hawaii so he found an inexpensive piece of land far away from the city and set up his modest home with his puppy Xena by his side. He was struggling with bills so he put his precious metal sword seen in Xena episode "Dreamworker" and Hercules episode "Sword of Veracity" on ebay to get a little relief. I won the sword to my delight and starting conversing with Bob as we both loved our props and of course had the same interests. We started a little website together called "Xena Fun" explaining one of my emails to this day that is still active.

The site was coming together nicely but slow and Bob informed me about his illness, he was not feeling well and getting tired easily. The site slipped away but

we remained good friends, he even made a few surprise phone calls to me that was very sweet and unexpected. As Bob's illness progressed he told me that he had no financial means to pay for doctors and did not have health insurance being a few years shy from collecting Medicare. I asked my brother a social worker in Arizona at the time to call him and see what he could do to assist Bob but he just seemed to fall through the cracks in getting any treatments and his illness became worse. Bob finally got on board with an experimental treatment program and I did a charity auction for Angel Flight because I was delighted he may have the opportunity to get transportation from them to get his treatments in Las Vegas. Unfortunately he was not responding well enough to treatment and sadly informed me that he was going into hospice. I had very little contact with him after that and then all contact stopped.

New Owners for an Old Friend's Collection

During our friendship Bob shared his collection with me sending pictures that I have saved of his many chakrams, swords, Xena photos, various replicas and more. I know for sure he had a metal Icons chakram, Creation items, a Todd Coyle metal chakram and other replicas most of which ended up going to auction by his family. Just after Thanksgiving Day November 2007 I saw an auction on ebay for a huge LOT of Xena items and I recognized it to be Bob's collection right away. The auction had 20 minutes left and I bid because I wanted a few of the items, but it went quite high and I stopped bidding. I contacted the seller knowing they were Bob's family members to send them my condolences, as I now was sure he had passed on. They were very nice and confirmed that Bob did pass away quietly at his home in Walker Lake on September 15, 2007. I contacted the winner of the auction living in the U.K. to ask if they ever wanted to sell one of the Centaur swords that I was interested in particular and in doing so found they did sell 'The Debt' style sword to Liliias. This new owner of Bob's collection was confused about the COA's because many of them were not matching up correctly to the props so I helped with some of it because I knew a lot about his collection, seems his family did not know much as the auction descriptions were very vague and they stated they were not sure that some of the items were actually from Xena.

Following the Trail

Bob and I discovered a few years ago that we both had a Creation Xena Whip with the same exact low number on the Creation COA! Bob contacted Creation about it and they said send us a picture of your COA for authentication and we will issue you a new number, What? He got the new numbered COA and kept his old one explaining the confusion for the new owner on the Xena Whip COA's.

This auction winner informed me that the lot of items had various chakrams including a fake rubber chakram and a metal Icon that they decided to keep, other items were sold off. They mentioned that the metal Xena Creation sword in the lot of items had a handcrafted sharpened edge that was a surprise to them and I said oh yeah Bob told me he did that to his Xena weapons to make them

look really cool! Not long after Bob's death a metal chakram showed up on a dealer site with a description that said "The sides are sharp and would have been used as a hero close-up version". If in fact these edges are sharp seems that Rob Tapert gave prop makers permission to slice up his woman? A very coincidentally close timeline between the metal chakram sold on the dealer site and the period of time around Bob's death when his collection was being dismantled. A rare chakram that **could** have been altered like that by a previous owner has many issues and no doubt would decrease the value of a set used chakram. Through research I could not find where they had used a sharp chakram on set but if they did that would be a great rare fact to know about and why they needed to do that.

Lineage Lost

An approach was made to this dealer selling the metal chakram by Liliias regarding a sword and the chakram and they didn't/couldn't offer any form of assurance or authenticity other than their own COA or any information regarding provenance of the items.

Todd Coyle circulated very nice hand made metal unmarked chakrams before he became licensed and I have seen other expertly handcrafted old style and yin-yang chakrams circulated around on ebay from private parties that most likely are also unmarked. These unfortunately pose a very dangerous threat to a chakram without a COA bringing it back to the date of the original sale or owner. When dealers sell items, especially a most controversial chakram they cut the lineage off at the knees by issuing their own COA eliminating any others that can validate the origin. This does not mean the item is not authentic but reduces the origin to faith and trust alone in the dealer. If they include any COA's that may have come with the prop along with their own then that is perfect. To this day I have never received a COA from a dealer other than the standard that the dealers circulate. I would be very interested to know if a collector has indeed received any type COA along with the dealers standard COA. So what happens to these COA's and why would anyone feel it is prudent to throw them away or separate them from the prop?

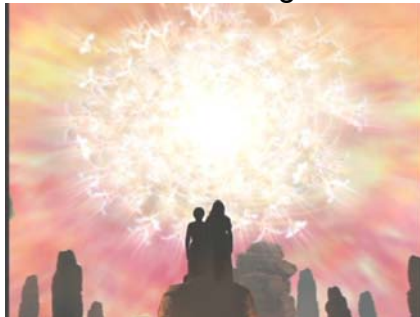
The Xena Museum and Athenaeum has this insightful theory.

"There are a number of reasons that this may occur. First, many COA's that have been issued are without merit like a Xerox Turner's receipt with no relevant information or a COA issued by a seller who no longer operates (like many who bought at the warehouse sales and were "dealers" just that once). The vast majority of Xena items had no official reliable COA. Also, many Xena items have COA's that misidentify the item, this even occurred with COA's issued by "It's a Wrap". In these cases the original paperwork can create more confusion than a solid provenance for the item. The dealer may see the paperwork as more of a hindrance than a help only serving to raise questions. These reasons may not be the best but sometimes not much is being lost. Another possibility is that old COA's may bear the names of previous owners whose privacy should be protected; the dealer could just redact the name off the document but often will

simply not turn it over at all. On the other hand, there could be other, more nefarious reasons for dealers not turning over old paperwork. They may just be careless or lazy, not bothering to keep the papers organized, it happens. Or they may not want a buyer to backtrack the ownership history, either so the buyer can't discover what may have been paid for the item in the past or who it was attained from. They may not want the identity of a previous dealer identified if it is a competitor or perhaps a less than reputable source. If they bought it for a song and are selling for a Kings' ransom, they may not want the new owner to be able to find that out so readily. Obviously it is not of comfort when the dealer is trying to hide something but I imagine that may occur sometimes".

The Xena Museum and Athenaeum does submit any paper trail on an item sold, when one exists, as well as myself and many collectors I have spoken to that are just moving this and that along occasionally. I, Barbie, feel that any papers that came with the items confusing or not is part of the story and history of that item and has much value.

Even though dealers have an obligation to be correct about their descriptions they too can be vulnerable to misrepresentation and authentication problems especially when they are selling props and wardrobe from hundreds of different movies and TV shows. I expect a dealer in step with their stellar reputations to ask the necessary questions to authenticate the item they will buy or sell on commission and do their own research, I believe most do. I think the private collector has that same right and obligation to ask dealers where the items are coming from and receive any paperwork submitted with the item excluding any monetary transactions, dealers do have the right to this privacy.



I miss Bob who loved his collection and I will always cherish the memory of his friendship and will never forget what it meant to him to be a Xena fan!

Prince Hercules boots worn by Kevin's stunt double, Patrick Kake, who in recent years has earned a name for himself as an actor: among various roles, he was Oreius the Centaur in the movie [The Chronicles of Narnia: The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe](#).

Having watched the It's A Wrap-Yahoo auctions obsessively, Mark recalls seeing the Prince Hercules cossie selling, minus the boots. It wasn't until the It's A Wrap warehouse sale (post auctions) that he found the boots in a big container of various boots/shoes. The boots were mostly shipped in separate containers, which may explain why many cossies were sold without their respective footwear.

The boots are practically mint, so Patrick must not have had much action in that episode. The two boots are tied together and the studio tag reads "Prince Herc" and labels inside both boots have Patrick Kake's name. Watching the episode you'll see these are definitely the boots for the costume, they are black leather and lace up the sides rather than the front. Notice the very common manila tag.
