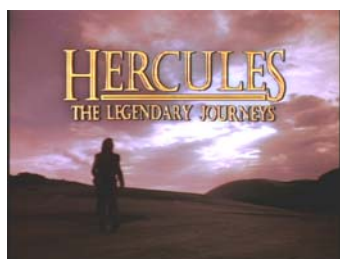

Michael Eric Hurst was born on September 20, 1957 in Lancashire, England. Michael as we know, a New Zealand actor and director was best known for his role as Iolaus in Hercules The Legendary Journeys and his role in Xena Warrior Princess in Episode "Prometheus". When I first saw the Character Charon I did not know it was Michael at first. Took me a while to recognize him as his acting was so wonderful taking on that character!

Michael married Jennifer Ward-Lealand in 1988. We most remember her playing the role of Boadicea in Xena "The Deliverer". She also was Voluptua in Hercules Episode "All That Glitters" and Zehra in Xena "The Play's the Thing". Michael and Jennifer have two sons Jack Louis Ward Hurst born in 1997, and Cameron Lane Ward Hurst, born in 1999. In 2003 Michael received the Laureate award from the Arts foundation of New Zealand. He was later designated an Officer of the New Zealand Order of Merit in 2005 for services to film and the Theatre. Jennifer was designated an Officer of the New Zealand Order of Merit for services to the theatre and the community this year. We will always be grateful for the character Iolaus that brought so much depth and meaning to a truly great series Hercules The Legendary Journeys, thank you Michael!

New Zealand Collection

It is rare for collectors living outside Australia and New Zealand to acquire these large set pieces due to issues with shipping. Below we have some large set dressing items along with some rare and unusual props. This truly great collection is owned by Beth, an avid supporter of Michael's New Zealand theatre and acting/directing endeavors. There will be more photos over the coming months. ENJOY!

Here is a figural plinth seen during the Dahak exorcism in Hercules episode "Redemption".



Lute played (badly) and carried around by Iolaus and played by Hercules acting like Kiss in Herc Episode "Just Passing Through". The back is padded suede, with a wide suede carry strap. There is one more lute in existence from this episode, used in the later temple scene where a string broke. It was sold on ebay a few years ago. This is actually a non-working prop, beautifully made. A somewhat similar lute was played by Joxer in Bitter Suite.

Serpent (asp?) hangers seen on Xena and were in Queen Nefertiri's wardrobe Hercules Season 6 episode "City of The Dead" where Iolaus rifled through the clothing before finding the secret passage.

Here we have a very large (about 2-feet high) rubber stunt urn, painted streaky blue and gold and 2 simple set dressing small pots



Brown ornate pottery vase, a bronze color metal vase with flower motif and one of Beth's favorite props ever -an extremely heavy black pottery jug with dragon motif in relief. It was first used in The Enforcer on Hercules, in a bar where the Enforcer sent by Hera to kill Hercules picks it up and drinks its entire contents. Funny thing is in a few scenes later in ANOTHER bar it is on the counter there when Iolaus and a friend are talking! Amazing this prop survived and Beth has never seen another one like it. With the dragon on it could see it being used later on Xena.

Prince Hercules boots worn by Kevin's stunt double, Patrick Kake, who in recent years has earned a name for himself as an actor: among various roles, he was Oreius the Centaur in the movie [The Chronicles of Narnia: The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe](#).

Having watched the It's A Wrap-Yahoo auctions obsessively, Mark recalls seeing the Prince Hercules cossie selling, minus the boots. It wasn't until the It's A Wrap warehouse sale (post auctions) that he found the boots in a big container of various boots/shoes. The boots were mostly shipped in separate containers, which may explain why many cossies were sold without their respective footwear.

The boots are practically mint, so Patrick must not have had much action in that episode. The two boots are tied together and the studio tag reads "Prince Herc" and labels inside both boots have Patrick Kake's name. Watching the episode you'll see these are definitely the boots for the costume, they are black leather and lace up the sides rather than the front.



Anyone who has this wardrobe can purchase the boots for \$100 plus shipping the same price Mark originally paid.

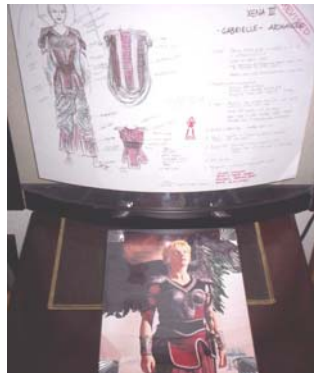

I already own Amazon boots labeled Hippolyta with the signature metal hook pattern seen throughout the H1 Movie 'Hercules and the Amazon Women'.



Below is an oddly shaped purple Amazon top I recently acquired with a label that says Hippolyta then Binding written on top of the words Stunt DBL. This style top was seen in the movie “Hercules and the Amazon Women”. Other than Roma Downey’s part as Hippolyta there were other Amazon women wearing this same type purple top. In the screen cap you can see the long strips of fabric in the front where they stick out from under the armor, I laid the strips on the mannequins arms for better viewing. The top is very unusual and has lots of ties and loops. Seems complicated to put together correctly and I may not have set it up properly on the mannequin. I checked whoosh and found an actress name Carly Binding who played character Barb Binder in Xena Season Six Episode “Soul Possession” so I don’t know if there might be any correlation there or if she appeared as an extra in the HM1.

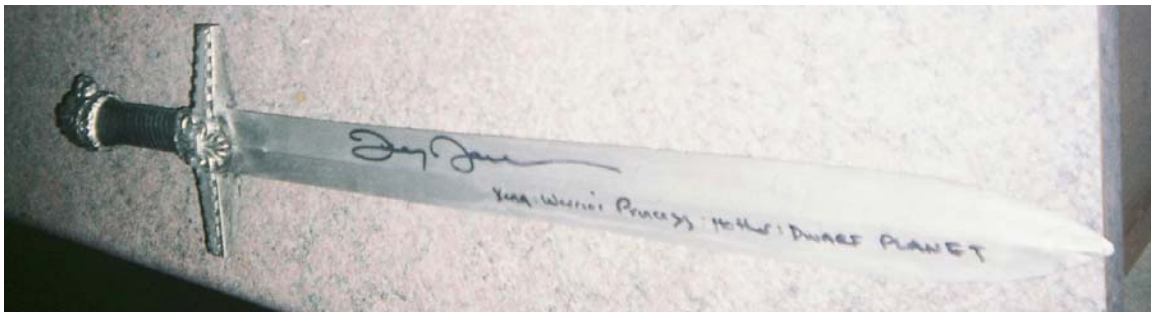

Q 1 I was wondering how do you respond to people who do not understand why you would want to collect prop and wardrobe items? I am asking because although my friends are supportive of my hobbies one of them recently said that it was "embarrassing" to have people come over to the house because I had my props and wardrobe in display cases where they could "be seen." She said a collection is one thing but displaying them makes it seem like I was creating some sort of "shrine to an old TV show." Wow, I didn't really know how to respond to that especially since my collection is limited to my office where nobody else needs to go and does not spread to the rest of the shared household. I just said that I would never make that comment about anyone's collection if that collection meant something to them personally. People collect ALL sorts of items-stamps, coins, pins, animal figurines, model cars, etc. Do other people feel this way? Just curious because I don't really feel a need to defend my collection, but it seems like other people think I somehow need to come up with a good reason. **MORGAN**

Q 2 Do you have a prop/wardrobe piece or collection that you sold or traded that you wish now you had not parted with? **JENNY**

A 1 Some time ago I read a small piece in a book or magazine when Lucy was asked to describe the Xena series in one sentence after the end of the 6th season. Now this may or may not be a real quote, but I still liked it - the sentence was 'For a brief moment there was magic'. The genuine props and costumes were part of the magic, a part you can touch and hold. Who wouldn't want to show off something that existed in a magical world, which evidences the creation of a myth of epic proportions, something which was unique and can never be mimicked or equaled. To own a prop is to own part of the miracle, and miracles should never be hidden away.

LILIAS

A 1 People DO collect all kinds of things (I grew up as a coin collector which I got from my Dad) and part of the collecting activity is to display the items, or at least arrange them so you can view them at will. There are people who put things in a bank safety deposit box, but that seems to defeat the main purpose of collecting X:WP items. We want to see what we've spent so much time, energy, and money collecting. The fact that you've taken the time to create displays for your items shows how much you care about your collection and the displays are the best protection for them, too.

I'll be honest, no one has seen the entirety of my collection, for several reasons: (1) it's a lot of work to bring it all out, which is why only a fraction is on display, (2) some people have a more narrow interest in X:WP items than I do (I also collect original X:WP art, for example), (3) every time I bring something special out, there is a risk of damage, and finally (4) did I mention how much work it is? I have a separate bedroom where my collection resides, some items displayed, most not, as the room just isn't big enough. Of the items that are on general display (prop weapons, original art) non-Xenites have always appreciated the pieces. My dissertation chair recognized my Xena sword in its display case and marveled at the inscription on the scabbard (and this woman has to approve my Ph.D dissertation!). Last, but not least, my octogenarian parents (especially my Dad) really love my Xena fan and collecting activities. I think it's the "friend" who has the problem, not your collection.

A 1 These props were made with much care and are actually very rare items. They were made to depict stories revolving around Greek mythology that has been recognized since man could write. For example only 40 resin swords from one mold were made for that sword type, hence, very rare if you place that circulating in the entire world with no more to be made ever again. Wardrobe pieces were hand sewn and are so rare that if you own one you MAY never find another again. I have seen more people covet a \$400 designer purse or sneaker that was pumped out by the millions seen at every street corner, I like owning things that very few other people have!

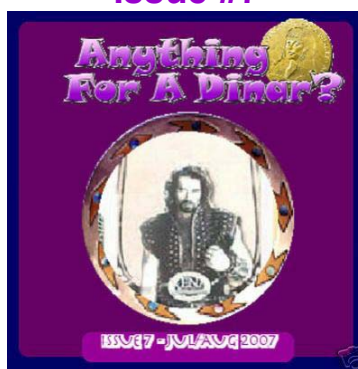

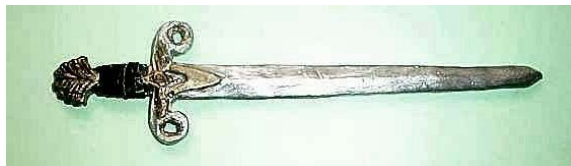
