Desperately Seeking Xena
by Chris Clogston

“Every passion borders on chaos, that of the collector on the chaos of memory.”
Walter Benjamin, ‘Ich packe meine Bibliothek aus’
(quoted in *To Have and To Hold*)

Are you a Xena collector? And if so, what kind of Xena collector are you? And actually, let me back up a little and ask the questions more generically, "Are you a collector? What kind of collector are you?" There are several different types of collectors, which can also be described as different personalities, or psychologies. I had put a poll on my XenaStuff blog last year asking that question -- What kind of Xena collector are you? With five possible choices: Aggregator, Passionate, Hobbyist, Investor, and Expressive.

There are collectors who I call *aggregators*: they try to collect anything and everything related to the subject matter. This type of collector will collect expensive items as well as cheap items, with the only criteria being that the items are related. This type of collector is also one that can be frustrated, because it's nearly impossible to "complete" the collection, especially if the collection also holds merchandised items, which seem to breed on their own. If you look at the poll results near the end of this article, you'll see that four Xena collectors identified themselves as aggregators.

A famous aggregator is Steve Sansweet, the Director of Content Management at Lucasfilm Ltd and is also in charge of fan relations in the Marketing dept. Sansweet has the largest Star Wars collection outside of the Lucas Archives, and he's had to add on to his house three times to contain it all (he even added a floor!). And Sansweet has an "in" working for the creator of the films where his collection originates. The Archives always has the right of first refusal, and so that is where the best items have gone -- I think that a lot of people might agree that that is proper. Steve Sansweet has written extensively about Star Wars collecting for the *SW Insider*, written several sets of trading cards, and has published several books focusing on different aspects of collecting Star Wars (most recently with *The Star Wars Vault: Thirty Years of Treasures from the Lucasfilm Archives*).

An almost-aggregator, though most people don't realize it, is film director Peter Jackson. Have you wondered why all of those *LOTR* costumes and props have never hit the open market? To make the trilogy, many thousands of costumes and tens of thousands of props and weapons were fabricated. [I happen to know that while the X:WP auction was going on, It's A Wrap! was preparing a bid to sell the *LOTR* items]. However, Jackson owns them all as part of his fee for working on the extended version of *The Return of the King* DVD release. Jackson intends to build a museum, presumably in New Zealand, in order to display this wealth of filmmaking art. Peter Jackson's collection comes pre-assembled - - he won't have to go out and find desirable items for his collection -- he has it all.

You might have noticed that I haven't asked what might seem to be the primary question, "Why do you collect Xena?" When you are talking to other Xena fans, the answer isn't necessary because you won't be asked the question -- the answer is understood by everyone in the Xena community. Non-Xenites don't get it, but then again, they missed out on a transgressive, cutting edge, entertaining and break-through television program, the echos of still reverberate throughout post-Xena programming.

New York City art professor Marilyn Gelfman Karp writes in her beautifully photographed coffee table book on collecting, *Inflagrante Collecto*, that “Collecting is not about what you collect as much as it is about who you are. Collections are about recollection. Collections exclude the world and are symbolic of it. Writing about why one collects what one collects is a bit like self-psychoanalysis; it’s hard to be objective” (11).

Earlier, I described a type of collector that I call "the Aggregator", a completist collector whose goal is to collect every possible item related to their collection subject. I realize now that I didn't put forth a definition of "collector". One definition that I find particularly useful:

"We define a collector as a person who is motivated to accumulate a series of similar objects where the instrumental function of the objects is of secondary (or no) concern and the person does not plan to immediately dispose of the objects. Thus a person who accumulates a variety of toasters but does not use them to make toast is a collector of toasters. A person who buys and sells old books but never sets aside any of them for a personal collection is not a collector. Collectors of both fine art and bottle caps fit our definition, and we suggest that while the resources at the disposal of those who collect these two classes of objects differs greatly, the social-psychological motivations underlying their behavior do not" (McIntosh and Schmeichel 86).

You are a collector if you accumulate related items, do not plan to use the items, and do not plan to dispose of the items. That's a pretty basic definition of collecting.

Several Xenites at conventions have told me that if a Xena movie were to be made, my props and costumes would come in handy for the filmmakers. Of course that would render my collection defunct: it would no longer be a collection but would be working props and costumes. Going back to the above definition of a collection: these items are a collection because they are taken “out of action”; they are removed from being functional in their original sense.

Other types of collectors are identified by different sources:

1. Passionate collectors, who are obsessive and emotional. They will pay any price for the right item (see also Belk, 1991, on irrational aspects of collecting behavior).
2. Acquisitive collectors, who see collecting as an investment.
3. The hobbyist, who collects purely for enjoyment.
4. Expressive collectors, who collect as a statement of who they are. These types suggest some overt motivations for collecting: profit, the emotional thrill of acquisition (intense but short-lived positive affect), pleasure (mild but consistent positive affect), and self expression or aggrandizement (Saari 1997).

Xena collectors who voted that they consider their collection to be an extension of their personal expression would agree with Dr. Karp’s statement above that the collection is more about “who you are”. Among Xena collectors I've seen examples of all five types

(the four listed above and including the aggregator). Here are the poll results to the question What kind of Xena collector are you?

Passionate (I'm Obsessed)	16
Hobbyist (It's enjoyable)	19
Acquisitive/Investment	1
Expressive (This is ME!)	8
Aggregator (I want it all!)	4
Totals	48 votes/36 voters

I allowed voters to choose more than one category for themselves and the majority of voters described themselves as both Passionate and Hobbyist (which is how I describe myself). Passionate collectors are very connected emotionally to the objects already in their collection as well as to objects desired to add to the collection. Hobbyist collectors, by definition, are not trying to make any income from their collection: it's an enjoyment, a past time, and a nexus for information gathering and research.

Most of us also love to share our collections with other collectors with the same interests; after all, like-minded collectors will understand your collection instantly – there are a lot of great Xena collection websites listed in this Newsletter each month – check them out.

And while not reflected as a potential answer in the poll, all Xena collectors of costumes and props are passionate about the television show and still enjoy it (we might not be obsessively watching it any longer, but the fondness remains). I would go so far as to say we still love Xena: Warrior Princess, and we have the displays in our homes to express it visually.

Need to sell multiple Xena/Hercules Props and Wardrobe? Say Auction!

Lets have some fun bidding on our terms without ebay fees and build our collections through other serious Xena and Hercules enthusiasts. We all need to sell items occasionally for various reasons so instead of dealing with the ebay rules and fees lets try selling among ourselves rendering a most satisfying and fun transaction for all.

Xena Prop House will announce the starting time and end of your auction with a comprehensive presentation of what you are selling then you set up the auction. The auction will be backed by XPH through assisting and referring readers and collectors to your designated auction time

circulating your email and information throughout the duration of your auction. If you are a new reader and participant that I have never communicated with before and would like to announce your own auction no problem just give me one reference from a seasoned collector I can communicate with to verify your commitment to your auction before I can announce it. This is a great way to make quicker bulk sales but XPH will still keep “**A Day in the Life**” section for the casual individual sale items and for photo sales. I can announce multiple auctions so there is no need for a first come first serve basis.

Auction guidelines and suggestions for the seller and what you do to get started:

1. Contact Barbie at XPH and communicate that you would like to run an email auction. Xena Prop House issues come out by the 15th of every month so you would need to make contact by the 7th of each month leaving time for the auction to be worked up by me and announced in the issue. It would be suggested you start the auction at least 4-7 days after the issue comes out on the 15th so readers have a chance to read about your auction introduce themselves as a potential bidder and your preparation to start receiving their bids.
2. Have a file ready that includes pictures, descriptions and starting bid prices of your items to be auctioned that can be inserted or attached to your email being mailed out to addresses of all interested potential bidders. I will list one picture for each item in my XPH announcement but bidders may want to request from you close-ups or additional shots of the item they are bidding on.
3. Submit to XPH the starting and ending date and time including your time zone of your auction so potential bidders can participate at any point during that time, one week duration is recommended. Extending the auction time past the date given to XPH is at the discretion of the seller, however the starting date needs to be the exact date and time as stated to XPH so all bidders have a sense that the auction is valid by starting on time as announced by XPH.
4. Decide on an "opening bid" for each item. Remember that this item could potentially sell for the opening bid, but you also want it low enough to attract bidding activity. You could also decide to accept "best offers" and have no opening bid, the amount of the highest offer is then the current "bid." Decide on what payment methods will be accepted and the shipping carrier.
5. Formulate an organized system to receive bids through email and efficiently record the bidding amounts that will create the next bid according to your designated bid increment, they should be no less than \$5.00 bids increments.
- 6 Circulate email daily to bidders with the current bids so they know where they stand on their bid (as they know what bid amount they submitted) and can decide to continue to email you bid increments or not.
7. Emails you send to the individual bidders should be sent to them privately or concealed so no one else knows who the other bidders are unless they disclose that among themselves. It creates a much friendlier environment for bidding if you don't know who the participants are because in many cases it may be a Xena 'friend' you are bidding against.

Here is an example:

Hello everyone,

Here is where the bids stand as of the end of the day

- Sword: \$125
- Gauntlets: \$50

- Boots: \$50
- Tankard: \$25

Bids will be accepted until the Auction closes at your designated DATE AND TIME to also include your time zone.

The following day, do the same thing. Anyone can email you at anytime to bid; but only the current prices are shown. Your final email can show names if you so choose. For example:

Hello everyone,

Here are the RESULTS of the auction, and the winners

- Sword: \$235-Barbie
- Gauntlets: \$89-Morgan
- Boots: \$120-Tedra
- Tankard: \$90-Chris

Bidding is closed. Winning bidders will receive 'congratulations you won' email asking for addresses from winners so payment instructions and shipping information can be given.

That's it! You are in business on your own but with a little help!

Auction guidelines and suggestions for the bidders

1. If you may be interested in bidding on announced items you can email the seller early to get on board as a potential bidder. You are not obligated to bid at any time but will be recognized as a bidder that may be waiting to see how high items go before you decide to bid or **not**.
2. If you do place a bid please make sure you can honor that bid amount. Bid retractions can cause an unpleasant trickle down effect to other bidders.

The Lucy Kimono wardrobe comes with two COA's one is from SPLW (Snake Pit Leather Works) and the other is Leena aka (Xena Trade Center) Leena got it from snake pit and then also issued her own COA. Xena Kimono top has a tag but it got charred so it is not legible.



Prince Hercules boots worn by Kevin's stunt double, Patrick Kake, who in recent years has earned a name for himself as an actor: among various roles, he was Oreius the Centaur in the movie [The Chronicles of Narnia: The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe](#) .

Having watched the It's A Wrap-Yahoo auctions obsessively, Mark recalls seeing the Prince Hercules cossie selling, minus the boots. It wasn't until the It's A Wrap warehouse sale (post auctions) that he found the boots in a big container of various boots/shoes. The boots were mostly shipped in separate containers, which may explain why many cossies were sold without their respective footwear.

The boots are practically mint, so Patrick must not have had much action in that episode. The two boots are tied together and the studio tag reads "Prince Herc" and labels inside both boots have Patrick Kake's name. Watching the episode you'll see these are definitely the boots for the costume, they are black leather and lace up the sides rather than the front.

Notice the very common manila tag.







It is the matching design to the Hephestus hero sword that I have minus the jewels. It has a resin handle and a closed cell foam blade with the metal rod in the center, it measures 12 1/2" from tip to pommel. I shot the pics next to the Hep sword so you would be able to see the same design.

It looks to have a leather wrapped handle but was actually made in the mold and painted to have that appearance.

2. Here is a wonderful sword made of hard resin same style used in second season Hercules episode “Under A Broken Sky” and they re-used it later by adding a rounded little top on the head for Cyanne's sword in XWP.

3. Here's another new arrival...a resin handled amazon sword with a foam blade same style used in episode 'To Helicon and Back' being a brown color handle/grip...probably used by a queen.

4. Here's a new item arrival the hero outfit of Hephestus from Young Hercules. The screen caps are from episode "Keeping Up With The Jason's" but was used in other episodes also. All outfit pieces are labeled 'Hephestus' and made completely out of leather and beaten copper and metal, quite a heavy outfit but well deserving for a God. It is a partial outfit and is missing the ringed necklace, the single armband, a pair of wrist bands that are worn in conjunction with the gauntlets and the copper toed boots listed in "The Quest" section.



5. Hand Cuffs

These style hand cuffs were used throughout the Xena an Hercules series. They are made of heavy resin with hinges so they can open up. They have a wire loop at the clasp connection so you can add locks to the set. The chain is made of hard plastic and the inside of the cuffs are lined with soft leather so they won't rub the actors/actresses wrists. An unusual and well made item that you don't see around too often



That would be places like Bethells Beach Kare Kare Falls etc. We had tons of fun. But of course we got into tons of trouble, much like the dumpster diving story in real life. I told Torey that I felt like a real life Thelma and Louise the way we were running around NZ! We were constantly getting lost but having fun doing so- and don't even get me started on a right hand drive car! Geeze! How do they do it??? I was constantly reminding Torey NOT to shift the windshield wipers instead of the signals (as that is where we are USED to shifting them on the steering wheel) and driving on the WRONG side of the road! That is just a weird feeling no matter what to us YANKS! It had to be as weird to Lucy learning to drive OUR way when she came Stateside as it was for us.

As we were driving to Bethells I noticed a tree that was always being filmed in both Xena and Hercules. I told Torey to pull off to get a pic of that tree. Well because she didn't see the left side of the car (I did as I was the passenger) I saw that she was pulling into mud- it rains a lot in NZ, I told her " Not there! " But it was too late as we slogged into the mud! She said (growling Xena

This time it was the lake for Femmes, Gems and Fins. And that lake was cold! And deep mind you! After that we headed back. It felt really good going to the places they had filmed in, and seeing the exact same places as well. Kare Kare falls was the place where Many Happy Returns was filmed, as was Altared States. I took pics of the big fern that held their clothes at the time. I was then invited to the set (see pics to top off this first visit.) I met Gerry and Tammy the stunt double mains for the second unit. Both were very nice. All of the crew were incredibly nice, and it was a real trip being on the set of what Kevin Sorbo called "the Port" which is where the ship is docked with the eye painted on it. They were filming Tsunami at the time that I was there.

There were lots of places that they filmed, but those were the two that stood out the most. New Zealand was the most beautiful country I have ever been to, and I went back in 2001 on another vacation to do a few more things. One of the things we did was a 300 ft drop in the lost world that was in Waitomo caves outside of Hamilton. That was known as the "Rambo" trip we also walked on the Mount Tarawera volcano that year.






