Here is a new section that will be written and submitted by Morgan Sumners every month. Her humorous wit is just too precious and this will be a permanent section, Enjoy!

After the Xena series ended in 2001, and Pacific Renaissance (I always thought that would be a great name for a rock band!) packed up all the weapons, wardrobe, and set dressing pieces for shipment to the Turner auction, Xenites everywhere began to focus their energy on begging for a Xena movie, rewriting a happier ending to FIN, and posting You Tube videos of the “kiss of life,” carefully and painstakingly redone in super slow motion.

But little did they know that the Turner auction would set off a spark called prop collecting that soon turned into a raging inferno. And some of us would get burned...literally. Once all the paraphernalia was disbursed and many New Zealanders' checkbooks were still smoking, the wonder that is eBay and UPS worldwide would enable many of those precious props to land in the hands of fans everywhere. The horrifically painful visual of a family of half-crazed field mice using Gabrielle's scroll bag for an afternoon snack just makes my fillings hurt. Or it could be that triple chocolate layer cake I had for an afternoon snack. Either way, I don't want to think about it.

Yet here we are, embarking on a never-ending quest to find and add these little gems to our collections. And some not so scrupulous characters have tried to capitalize on our collective insanity. Sure, we all love a great bargain. But there are limits.....

Morgan: Hey you guys, check this out! This dude is having a Xena prop GARAGE SALE! Can you believe it??? Hasn't he ever heard of eBay???

Barbie: I understand that he inherited three storage buildings worth of stuff from his brother, who suddenly and unexpectedly abandoned prop collecting to start a meditation center.

Tedra: Can you blame him? It probably took him six years just to find the sword of Ares, only to find that the closed cell foam blade smelled like mothballs and had been gnawed on by a rabid squirrel.

Brad: I need to see that sword! Is this the place?
